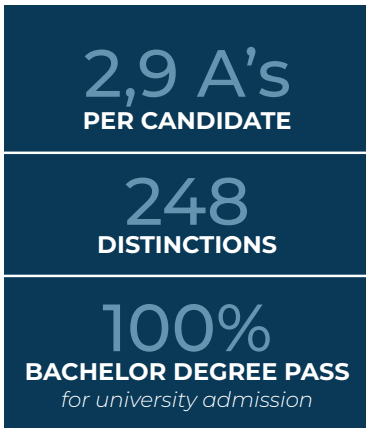
2025 NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE RESULTS

B AGGREGATES OR HIGHER



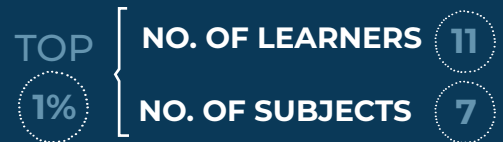
Our **ACADEMIC RUNNER UP** for 2025 is Zanele Nkomo who obtained an 87% aggregate with 6 distinctions.



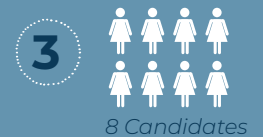
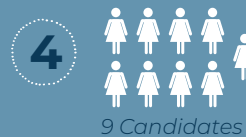
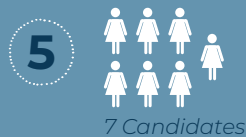
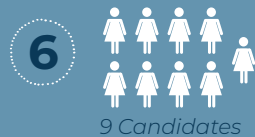
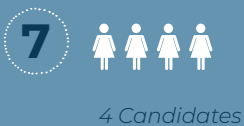
